Verizon brings DoS defense to Asia

COMMUNICATIONS service provider Verizon Business has extended a new security product to protect companies against Web-based attacks to the Asia-Pacific region. Called Denial of Service (DoS) Defense Mitigation, the offering was previously limited to Europe and the United States. Distributed DoS attacks are often used by malicious hackers to flood corporate networks and prevent legitimate data traffic from passing through. Verizon DoS Defense Mitigation services will help to intercept and redirect malicious traffic to designated mitigation centres before they can compromise the customer's network. The service is now available in eight Asian countries including Singapore, Hong Kong, Japan and South Korea.
